

## **Key Stage 1 (RECEPTION, Y1, Y2)**

In the early years we hope that parents will complement the work of the school in the following way :-

- 1.By taking an interest in the work the child is doing at school and seeking where possible, to extend this through conversation, play, visits, etc.
- 2.by providing children with the opportunities to draw, colour, paint, make models and to communicate their thoughts and ideas to others.
- 3.By sharing books with children and – when they are ready – to set aside a quiet time every evening to read books together.
- 4.By helping children to develop writing and number skills.
- 5.To help children learn some basic spellings which will be sent home.

## **Key Stage 2 (Y3, Y4, Y5, Y6)**

Children will be expected to learn tables, number facts and spelling on a regular weekly basis. They will be asked to undertake short individual assignments in Mathematics, English and Humanities or occasionally expected to complete work started in class. We would hope that all children will read each evening, preferably sharing the book and the enjoyment with parents.

All pupils will be issued with a LCP study book in English and Mathematics, appropriate to their ability. This is to be worked through at home under the supervision of parents and under the direction of the classteacher.
