



## Bookings & Payment for TRIPS & Clubs

Bookings for the Breakfast & the after school Stay and Play (SAP) Club are made online through the **Eduspot** (School Money) Website. This is also the method of paying for other clubs AND trips.

## Breakfast Club & SAP (after school) Club

Both the Breakfast and SAP Clubs are becoming more and more popular, so we do recommend that bookings are made as far in advance as possible. Both clubs are open to all pupils attending Sherborne Abbey CE Primary School, and cost £3.50 per hour (or part thereof)

Bookings for the Breakfast and SAP Clubs are closed at **LUNCHTIME every Friday** for the following week – so please ensure that you log in and book for any sessions needed. You can book a half term at a time, and can amend bookings by clicking on the sessions. (*Contact the office if you need a reminder of your child's password*) <https://eduspot.co.uk/> You should see the screen below: click on the “sign in” button then the last option “school money parent login”

## Please also inform us if you change your email address or mobile number.

We appreciate that *sometimes* last minute bookings are needed. We will always try and help - but if you need to book for a session in the same week, then please contact the office to check availability. We accept debit cards for payment or will add the fee to your School Money account.

## Childcare Voucher Schemes

We accept payment for Breakfast & SAP (ONLY) using Childcare Voucher Schemes – but your employer has to be a member. Please check with the office if we are registered to use your employer's scheme.

If you are using Childcare Vouchers to pay, then please **DO NOT** book online, but contact the office.

## Breakfast Club

The Breakfast Club opens at 8am, it is £3.50 per pupil per session, and includes toast and a drink.

## Stay and Play (SAP) Club

The SAP Club runs for just under 2 hours, **from 3.20 until 5.15pm.**

If attending just for the first hour, choose **Session 1** online, and collect your child by **4.20.**

Pupils can attend their normal after school activity, (such as football or netball) and then join the after school care *just* for the second hour. You would choose **Session 2** online, and collect your child by **5.15.**

If you wish your child to attend **from 3.20 to 5.15**, then you need to pick **Session 3** (both hours) Please advise the class teacher that your child is going to SAP Club that day. Please ensure that the school is aware, and kept up to date of, any food allergies or medical conditions.

*We do have to match the expected number of children to appropriate staff.*

*So we may not be able to accommodate your child if they simply appear without booking!*

*If your child is booked in but does not attend,  
you may still be charged as we may have refused another booking.*
